

Devolution and LGR

- Letter sent to join priority programme from Luton, Bedford and Milton Keynes
- Analysis and decision made to form a BLMK Strategic Authority – led by Luton
- Central Bedfordshire taking 'open position'
- Waiting to hear back from Central Government
- No word on how local government restructure will impact Luton



Engagement with Westminster

- Development of key lobbying items:
 - Central government funding
 - Housing and TA
 - Child poverty and two child benefit cap
 - adult social care
 - allocation of asylum seekers
- Letters to PM, deputy PM and other ministers
- Engagement with child poverty taskforce
- Briefing of councillors attending Labour Conference LUTON

Portfolio holder and exec changes

- Reallocation of some elements of housing into finance portfolio
- New portfolio holder for children's health and wellbeing
- New portfolio holder for Adult Social Care

Luton 2040 is visionary and trail blazing. However, there is a need to address the following recommendations...





Theme: 2040

- Recommendation: Establish a data driven roadmap
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - Creation of 40 outcomes and measures for 2040, with milestones and targets
 - Reset of 2040 governance structure
 - Implementation of council-wide strategic
 - framework



Theme: 2040

- Recommendation: Partner and pledge development
- RAG rating: Orange
- Key actions:
 - 2040 roadmap creates new framework for pledges
 - Work with partners underway to refresh pledges within framework with demonstrable actions
 - 'Focus areas' for 2040 identified and launched early 2025

Theme: Finance and Transformation

- Recommendation: Financial management
- RAG rating: Orange
- Key actions:
 - CIPFA is currently undertaking a comprehensive independent external review of financial management.

Theme: Finance and Transformation

- Recommendation: Transformation capacity
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - The current portfolio is expected to deliver over £5m in budget savings over the coming year.
 - Work is continuing to drive the savings programme
 - towards the £13m target
 - New Head of Transformation appointed



Theme: Finance and Transformation

- Recommendation: People strategy delivery
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - The People strategy board has established five workstreams
 - Over 339 learning activities took place and 84% of our workforce participated in at least one learning event last year

Theme: Place

- Recommendation: Housing delivery
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - Amended Executive Portfolios
 - Staffing restructure
 - Member/officer board established to focus on housing delivery.
 - Identified parcels of "grey belt" land



Theme: Place

- Recommendation: Town centre
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - Appointed a new Head of Economic Growth and Strategic Regeneration
 - Work begun on Town Centre Delivery Plan
 - Formation of a dedicated Town Centre Taskforce



Theme: Place

- Recommendation: Economic growth strategy
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - Terms of Reference for the new Economic Growth Strategy agreed
 - Extensive stakeholder plan and evidence base developed
 - Regional economy strategy is also being produced.



Theme: Member development

- Recommendation: Executive decisionmaking
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - Refresh of the composition of the Executive
 - Mentors identified for new Portfolio Holders
 - Realignment of the Executive Portfolios
 - Quarterly Exec/CLT away days



Theme: Member development

- Recommendation: Councillor development
- RAG rating: Green
- Key actions:
 - Exec Team Building Day
 - LGA Charter Plus accreditation for Member Development retained
 - Business and Member Support team moving into Democratic & Electoral Services
